Criterion 8

Bereavement

Step 1

State your relationship to the deceased person/s (for example - son, cousin, close friend, student).

Step 2

What **impact** did bereavement have on your preparation for the TEE (or equivalent)? *(Place an X in the appropriate box.)*

Note: you must provide evidence to support your claim and that evidence must make clear the impact on your studies. The university may re-assess your claim based on the supporting evidence.

- Caused relatively minor distress
