Part 4 - Supporting documentary evidence

You are also required to provide appropriate documentary evidence to support your case for special consideration. Acceptable evidence includes:

- A statement from your School Principal (or an approved delegate) that addresses the disadvantage you are claiming;
- Medical documents or certificates;
- Reports from other health professionals, including registered counsellors and psychologists;
- Police reports; and
- Legal documents.

Unacceptable evidence includes:

- Character references that do not address the disadvantage you are claiming;
- School reports; and
- Other unofficial documents.

All claims must be supported by statements from appropriately authorised professionals. A statement from a school principal alone may not be sufficient evidence. For example, an applicant addressing Criterion 7 must include a statement from a medical practitioner or other health professional outlining the nature of the illness or medical condition, in addition to the statement from their school principal.
